

Nurse Aide Examination — COVID-19 Testing Requirements for Candidates

Nurse Aide Candidate Testing Requirements

- To protect other candidates and staff, you will not be admitted to the test center and you should reschedule your exam if you:
 - Have been diagnosed with COVID-19.
 - Have you been in close personal contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis *Medical and healthcare professionals - please see exception below.
 - Have had any flu-like symptoms in the last five days, including fever, chills, a cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath
 - Have been or are under home quarantine or centralized observation by government or healthcare authorities
- You will be asked to acknowledge that you meet the above health requirements and that you will follow health and safety guidelines while testing.
- You must bring and wear your own face mask while you're at the test center and throughout your exam. Candidates may not test without a face mask.
- Stay 6 feet away from other people in the waiting area and during the admissions process.
- Some test centers may require candidates to provide a temperature check upon arrival.

^{*}Medical and healthcare professionals where both the medical/healthcare professional and the patient were wearing the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) are an exception.
